

Horse Rescue & Sanctuary will be holding their 3rd annual charity trail ride/walk

Where: Mendon Ponds Park in Rochester

When: October 2, 2010.

This is a fundraiser to help feed and care for the 27 horses now in our care. Riders bring their own horses but if you don't have a horse you can bring your sneakers and walk any of the several trails in this gorgeous park. The horse trail is approximately ten miles long.

Proof of a negative Coggins test is required for all horses participating.

We will have an enclosed pavilion with a wood burning fireplace to keep everyone toasty and warm for those chilly October days. There is a free continental breakfast and lunch will be provided for all people that have registered (because of health laws the public is excluded). Sign in starts at 9:00 am and the first ride begins at 10:00 am. Lunch will be served when everyone is back from the first ride and those wishing to may go out for another ride in the afternoon after lunch.

We will have nice raffle prizes and a 50-50 drawing. The event is similar to a walk-a-thon except pledges will be a flat amount instead of by the mile. There will be a cash prize of \$100 to the person bringing in the most money in pledges. This is a fun day for everybody so don't miss out. Pre-registration is \$15 and registration at the event is \$20 so sign up early.
